Passport and Visa Requirements: Delegates will receive "Official Invitation Letter" issued by Ministry of Land and Resourses of the People's Republic of China via fax or E-mail for obtaining entry visa to China and/or for the travel approval from their organizations. Note: Passport must be valid for at least six months upon arrival.

Weather and climate: weather in late November here is relatively mild, but might be a little cold with temperature ranging from 1°C-15°C.

Clothing: a sweater and jacket are enough to cope with warm days, and you may also put a thicker coat in your baggage for cold days just in case.

Sightseeing and public transportation: Xi'an is one of the most renowned ancient cities with a long history of 3200 years. It has been the capital of the most important dynasties in Chinese history, including the Zhou, Qin, Han and Tang dynasties. Thus, Xi'an is well known for its rich historical and cultural attractions, such as the Terracotta Warriors and Horses, Xi'an City Wall of the Ming Dynasty, Great Wild Goose Pagoda and Forest of Stone Steles Museum.
