Passport and Visa Requirements

Delegates will receive "Official Invitation Letter" issued by CCOP via fax and/or e-mail for obtaining entry visa to Thailand and/or for the travel approval from their organizations.

Note: Passport must be valid for at least six months before arrival.

Reception Upon Arrival

Delegates will be welcome upon arrival at Krabi International Airport by the Thai staff and transferred to the Krabi Resort Hotel. Delegates should inform the organizer well in advance on their dates and times of arrival, and flight details. CCOP TS will reserve a hotel room for the participants. Note that you may need to transit in Bangkok to travel to Krabi from your country.

Currency: Thai Baht

Exchange rate is US\$ 1 approximately=Baht 33 Exchange of currency may be done at the airport, local banks, money exchangers and hotels around the city. Major credit cards are widely accepted.

Language

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT KRABI

Krabi is one of the Southern provinces in Thailand. Its shores fronted by the waters of the Andaman Sea is one of, if not, the oldest areas in which continuous settlement has been occurring in Thailand. Like the Northern districts, evidence of human settlement dates back to around 1200 A.D. and Krabi's many caves and excavated areas are testament to this, where a number of stone-age tools, cave paintings, pottery, beads and the likes have been found.

The 130 islands of the Andaman Sea and its waters make Krabi province a perfect place for recreation. The famous 'Phi Phi islands', known as 'Paradise on Earth' includes beaches, limestone sea cliffs and an underwater Eden, of colorful corals and numerous fish species. 'Lanta islands' lying to the East of Phi Phi and to the South of Krabi town includes stretches of mangroves with breaks of coral rimmed beaches and rugged hills, thick with forestation.

The mountainous geography is broken by highlands and plains on the mainland that make excellent exploring areas, filled with ancient history, hidden cave temples and national parks that beg exploration. The flora and fauna in many of these areas are still undiscovered and unrecorded in the science books, which makes this province more interesting.

The Krabi River flows 5 km through its namesake city from its source in the Panom Benja Mountains, teams with wildlife, from sea otters to sea eagles as do other rivers in the area. Krabi is waiting, don't be left standing with the masses, get lost in time and discover it for yourself.
