## **Background and Purpose of the Meeting:**

This meeting was organized by the ICB-CCOP1 Project China research team and financially sponsored by the Chinese government. The final report on Song Hong-Yinggehai basin cross-border case study and report on capacity building during the implementation of the ICB-CCOP1 Project were discussed in the meeting. It was a preparation meeting for the ICB-CCOP1 case study meeting and seminar on capacity building on 21-25 August 2007, in Phuket, Thailand.

## **Record of Proceedings and Discussions at the Meeting:**

Ms Wang Yan, Manager, Cooperation & Contract Block, Exploration Department, CNOOC Ltd. hosted the meeting. First, on behalf of CNOOC, Mr. Zhu Weilin, Vice President of CNOOC, conveyed his warm welcome to all participants attending this meeting. He stated that ICB-CCOP1 Project has provided a unique platform for CNOOC to build connection and develop good relationships with other CCOP Member Countries as well as to establish internal cooperation with China Geological Survey under the instruction of Ministry of Land and Resource, P. R. China. He mentioned that CNOOC had been glad to contribute to the Song Hong-Yinggehai basin cross-border joint case study and share existing knowledge and experience with Vietnamese partners and other CCOP Member Countries. Meanwhile, through the implementation of the ICB-CCOP1 Project activities, geoscientists from CNOOC not only contributed their own expertise, but also learned a lot from Danish experts and experts from other CCOP Member Countries. Through this project implementation, CNOOC people also developed their capacity in the involvement of international cooperation project and established friendship with other peers from various institutions of CCOP Member Countries. At the end, he stressed that CNOOC would like to continually get involved and support CCOP activities as usual.

Mr. Ma Yongzheng, Deputy Permanent Representative of China to CCOP, Deputy Division Director, Department of International Cooperation, Science and Technology, Ministry of Land and Resources gave his warm welcome to everybody and expressed his sincere thanks to CNOOC for hosting this meeting and supporting CCOP activities. Finally, he wished the success of the meeting.

Following up, Mr. Jiang Shijin, Director, Department of International Cooperation, China Geological Survey provided his valuable advice to this meeting. He said the meeting should focus on the final report of the case study and capacity building as well as proposal for ICB-CCOP project phase 2.

Mr. Liu Liqun gave a brief introduction of the implementation of the ICB-CCOP1 Project to the meeting and expressed sincere thanks to the strong support from Chinese government and valuable cooperation from Ministry of Land and Resources (MLR), China Geological Survey (CGS), and China Offshore Oil Corporation (CNOOC).

Next, Dr. Cai Feng, National Coordinator of ICB-CCOP1 Project, made a comprehensive presentation that covered regional geology, joint field study, basin modeling, petroleum system analysis and hydrocarbon potential. He summarized the outputs from the case study and described the achievements on capacity building. During his presentation, all the attendants gave their comments on this report, especially on the report figures and tables. This case study final report represented the outputs from joint case study between China and Vietnam, which was a remarkable achievement through the common efforts from Chinese and Vietnamese research team.

Mr. Liu Liquan introduced the preliminary initiative concept for the ICB-CCOP2 Project. The Capacity Building, Enhancement of Cooperation and Sharing of Geoscientific Knowledge for the Sustainable Development of the Petroleum Resources in the CCOP Region is the project target. The objectives will include the following aspects:

- Continue to enhance the research and exploration capacity within various governmental agencies of the CCOP Member Countries in the petroleum sector through case studies and transfer of available modern techniques and technologies for the exploration and exploitation of hydrocarbon.
- Promote cooperation within CCOP regions in petroleum business by enhancing networking, sharing and integrating existing knowledge of the petroleum systems in the region and disseminating knowledge captured in Member Countries.
- Contribute to the efforts of the CCOP Member Countries to promote investment in petroleum industry that can contribute to integrated regional economic development.

The project activities were composed of workshop, seminar, meeting, training course and expert visiting, etc. including CO<sub>2</sub> mapping, deepwater E&P technology, high-temperature & high-pressure issue and fractured reservoir. Certainly, the cross-border sharing basin joint case study will be continued in the selected basins.

Chinese participants expressed their interests in continuous support and participation in the ICB-CCOP project. They are willing to contribute and promote the cross-border case study.
